

THE HOWARD SCHOOL'S 4-POINT PLAN FOR REOPENING CAMPUS

The Howard School is excited to welcome Summer Safari campers to campus beginning Monday, July 6. This 4-Point Plan summarizes our procedures to keep everyone as safe as possible on campus by keeping distance between people, increasing hygiene, and cleaning/disinfecting more frequently. The Plan was developed in close consultation with medical professionals, as well as CDC, public health, and state guidelines. SOCIAL DISTANCING

- To maintain social distancing, students will remain with the same cohort of children throughout camp, with a maximum of 12 students in a classroom—they will not change classrooms. Instead, adults will come to them.
- Faculty, staff, and students will be required to wear a face covering without a vent.
- Classrooms will be configured to allow for maximum space between desks/students and between the teacher and students.
- Lunch will be provided by SAGE following CDC guidelines.

CLEANING

- High touch areas of the school, such as bathrooms and door handles, will be disinfected at least twice daily.
- Classrooms will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected each evening.
- Teachers will also be cleaning frequently touched surfaces in between classes and during breaks.
 - Any shared items, such as pencils, will be sanitized after each use.
 - All cleaning products are included on the EPA Safe List.

- Every student and staff member will have their temperature taken upon arrival to campus each day, and we will partner with students and staff to ensure they stay home if necessary.
- All students and teachers will use hand sanitizer upon entering the school and will have scheduled hand washing and sanitizing breaks throughout the day.
- The health and well being of our community is our top priority.

HEALTH & WELLNESS

DROP OFF:

Students should arrive on campus at the front circle wearing a face covering.

PICK UP:

Campers will depart to carpool from their classrooms. Teachers will call students to come to their cars when their parents arrive at the front circle.

All visitors to the school must receive prior permission before entering the building. Safety protocols, including temperature scan and hand hygiene, must be followed.
